NUFF - Privacy Policy - April 2007

This privacy policy sets out how the Naturist UK Fact File (NUFF) uses and protects any information that you give NUFF when you use this website.

NUFF is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

NUFF may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from April 2007.

What information do we collect from visitors?

No personal information is collected from visitors who browse the NUFF web pages the site and access to the site does not require registration.

Should you wish to contact NUFF via our online form you will need to include a name and an email address so that we can reply to your query. This information will be used only to reply to your query and for no other purpose.

As a general rule, NUFF will not disclose any of your personally identifiable information, except when we have your permission or under special circumstances, such as when we believe in good faith that the law requires it.

## Cookies

Like many websites, the NUFF website uses cookies in order to provide you with a more personalised web service.

A cookie is a text-only string of information that we pass to your computer's hard disk through your web-browser so that the website can remember who you are. Cookies cannot be used by themselves to identify you.

A cookie will typically contain the name of the domain from which the cookie has come, the "lifetime" of the cookie, and a value, usually a randomly generated unique number.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
